## All Wrong

Titanic Belfast is a visitor attraction opened in 2012, and is a monument to Belfast’s maritime heritage on the site of the former Harland & Wolff shipyard in the



city’s Titanic Quarter where the RMS Titanic was built. On the 15 April 1912 the famous White Star liner the Titanic sank with the loss of more than 1500 lives. The ship ignored 6 iceberg warnings. The Bank Buildings was designed by Sir Robert Taylor and erected by Waddell Cunningham in 1785. The building is currently owned by

Primark, and was used as their flagship store in Northern Ireland from 1979 until it was sadly destroyed by fire on 28 August 2018. ... The fire damaged Bank Buildings is currently undergoing a complete restoration and repair of the building.
